# Junior and Para Canadian Road National Championships

Location: Beauce, Quebec

Dates: June 25 to July 1, 2025 with potential option to stay and race Avenir July 2-6.

Arrival airport TBC

Race Dates: June 27, 28, 29, 30, 2025

#### **Team Size**

The desired team size will be 4 female, 4 male athletes, and 4 para athletes. The ABA reserves the right to vary the team size of the project based on interest level, athlete performance level and logistical considerations.

#### **Selection Date**

Notification of selection to the team will be made the week of June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025. Mandatory team meeting will be June 7 at 16:00.

## **Eligibility**

To be eligible for selection to the team athletes must:

- Possess a current ABA license.
- Be born between 2007 and 2010 inclusive (ages 15-18 in 2025).
- Fill in the expression of interest found at <a href="mailto:this-link">this link</a> before May 15.

- There is no age restriction for Para Athletes.

#### Para Selection Criteria

Para athletes interested in attending the National Championships are asked to contact Petrina at <a href="mailto:coach@albertabicycle.ab.ca">coach@albertabicycle.ab.ca</a>. Priority will be given to athletes intending to race <a href="mailto:Canada Games">Canada Games</a>, then national race experience, then provincial race experience. We understand that races for certain para categories are limited and athletes may be asked to attend some provincial training days to asses readiness to race at Nationals.

#### Junior and U17 Selection Criteria

Athletes will be selected to the team objectively by both points and results, as well as subjectively by committee selection. Selection will be made in the following priority:

#### Men and Women

- Priority 1: Top 10 in a UCI ranked race between January 1, 2025, and June 1, 2025
- Priority 2: First Junior in Points
- Priority 3: First U17 in Points
- Priority 4: Committee selection

## **Qualifying Races - Selection by Points**

Points will be earned at the <u>Hay City Classic</u> Road Race and all stages in the <u>Stieda Classic</u>. Points will be awarded in Cat ½ for men and Cat 1/2/3 for Women, as indicated in Table 1 below. Temporary license upgrades will be available for these races, contact Petrina for more information. Points will only be awarded to U19 and U17 racers in the category, so if a Junior racer is 12<sup>th</sup> overall, but the second placed athlete born between 2007 and 2010 they will receive 18 points. Points will be allocated to all U19 and U17 racers in the category regardless of Provincial Affiliation, so if a rider from Saskatchewan is the second youth rider there will be no distribution of second place points. Points earned in the season can be viewed at this link.
